ZEBULON TOWN HALL WINS 2010 CHAMPION AWARD

The 12th Annual Champion Awards recognizing excellence in the Triangle commercial real estate industry were announced on April 29, 2010 by the Triangle Commercial Real Estate Women. Winner of Best Redevelopment Project was the Town of Zebulon's Town Hall, formerly the Wakelon School. In March 2007, Zebulon voters approved a plan to purchase the property from GlaxoSmithKline and renovations began in early 2008. The building now houses the town's administrative offices, including Finance, Planning, Parks and Recreation, Town Manager, Town Clerk, Council Chambers and Mayor's Office. A separate school building also located at the Zebulon Municipal Complex was renovated during the project into a new police station.

This is the second award won by the Town of Zebulon for the renovation project. On September 15, 2009, the Town of Zebulon received an Anthemion Award from Capital Area Preservation, Inc. for Rehabilitation and Adaptive Re-Use of the Wakelon School Building. The Anthemion Awards are given in recognition of outstanding dedication and commitment to excellence in historic preservation in Wake County.

Zebulon Parks and Recreation will host the 2010 GlaxoSmithKline/Tar Heel Leagues, Inc. 9-10 Year Old Midget League District 6 Baseball Tournament beginning on Friday, July 9th at Zebulon Elementary School Park.

Privilege License Renewals Are Coming!

If you own, operate, or conduct business in the Town of Zebulon, the Town will be sending out annual privilege license renewal invoices the first week of July. In order to avoid late penalties and fines, please pay your privilege license fee by August 1. It is against Town ordinances to conduct business in Town without paying the appropriate privilege license fee(s). Please remember the following:

- Businesses are required to pay the privilege license fee for each type of activity conducted.
- Businesses are required to pay the privilege license fee at each location a business is conducted.
- Businesses are required to pay the privilege license fee each time change in ownership occurs.

ANNUAL YARDWASTE SCHEDULE

The annual yardwaste and leaf schedule for July 2010 through June 2011 has been prepared. Please remember the following items when preparing your yardwaste and leaf piles:

1. Separate limbs/brush from leaves. If yardwaste is mixed with leaves, it can damage the leaf truck when we pick up your leaves.
2. Do not bag your leaves or yardwaste. Do not place them in a container.
3. Do not mix in trash or construction debris. We cannot place these items in our yardwaste facility.
4. We recommend mulching of your grass. We cannot pick up grass clippings.

We use two different types of trucks for collecting yardwaste and leaves. If you see a yardwaste truck go by without stopping to collect your leaf pile, we will be returning with the leaf truck during your collection week. ROLL BACK THOSE TRASH CARTS!

Recently staff has been receiving complaints about neighbors leaving their trash carts next to the curb for extended periods of time. We wish to remind all residents to place their carts at the curb prior to 7:00 a.m. on their pickup day and remove their carts, once emptied, by 7:00 p.m. on the same day. If your trash collection is missed and the cart was at the curb prior to 7:00 a.m., please call 269-5285 to report the missed collection. Please do your part to keep your neighborhood looking nice.

REPORTING A STREET LIGHT OUTAGE

Street lights add to our neighborhood comfort and safety. If you notice a street light which is malfunctioning, please report it promptly. You may call Progress Energy directly at 800-419-6356 or you can call Zebulon Public Works at 269-5285. Please have the following information available when you call:

1. Street address for the pole
2. Pole tag number (yellow tag on pole, eye level, with black numbers or letters – most tags in Zebulon end in BF)
3. Is the light cycling on or off, always off, or is there a different issue with the light?

Repairs will be completed usually within 3-5 business days. Thank you for your help!

RAIN BARRELS AVAILABLE FOR SALE

The Town of Zebulon has 80 gallon rain barrels available for purchase to help conserve water. Rain water captured in the barrel is an excellent source for watering plants and vegetable gardens. The barrels are 38" high, 28" wide and are furnished with a faucet, two overflow valves, two screws to secure the lid, a built-in screen in the lid and instructions. Each barrel is \$90.00. If you would like to purchase a barrel, please come to the Finance Department at Town Hall, 1003 N. Arendell Avenue. Once payment is received, the Public Works Department will deliver the barrel to your home.
