Executive Summary:

The attached financials are for Board of Commissioners review only. See discussion below for details on statements.

Background:

The attached financials are a summary of revenues and expenditures to date. These are provided to keep the Board informed, on a monthly basis, of how revenues and expenditures are trending throughout the year.

Information:

These financial statements are through August 22, 2016. We have now received eleven months of sales tax and three quarterly distributions of utilities sales in FY 2016. These revenues for FY 2017 will not be received until starting in October. As usual, the majority of property taxes will be received later in the year as well. See notes below for analysis on those and other revenues.

For FY 2017, still just 7 weeks in to the new year, the Town spent 10% (approximately \$1.12 million) of its General Fund amended budget of \$11,302,905. This is comparable to last year's year-to-date expenditures, which were 15% of budget. It is still too early in the year to discuss trends in revenues or expenditures. The revenue and expenditure statements are still included for your review.

A few highlights to date include:

Sales tax

- Sales taxes collected in May 2016 were received and were 5.5% more than the distribution received for the same period in FY 2015.
- For the first eleven months of FY 2016 they are 7.09% (\$56,839) ahead of FY 2015.
- Article 39 receipts, proceeds returned to the county of origin, were 6.5% more in May than the distribution received for the same period in FY 2015.
- Article 39 totals are ahead of last year's year-to-date total by 7.14% (\$26,474). (Ref. attached Sales Tax Collections spreadsheet).

Utilities Sales Tax (Sales tax on natural gas, electricity, telecommunication services and video programming)

- The final quarter of FY 2016 Utilities Sales distribution will be received in mid-September for the quarter ending June 30, 2016. The first three quarters were up 6% (\$26,096) from what was received the first three quarters of FY 2015.
- The first distribution for FY 2017 will be received in mid-December.



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Property Tax

- Total current year property tax collections for FY 2017 are approximately \$173,000. This is 3.25% of budgeted revenues (\$5,315,000).
- This is 23% more than what was collected to date in FY 2016 (\$140,411).
- The majority of current year property tax collections are received from November – January.

Permits & Zoning

- Permit and zoning fees collected in FY 2017 are \$8,938.
- This is 14% of budgeted revenues (\$65,000) for the year.
- It is about 18% less than what was collected to date in FY 2016 (\$10,968).

Transportation Impact Fees

- Transportation Impact fees collected for FY 2017 total \$3,109.
- This is 12% of budgeted revenues (\$25,000) for the year.
- It is 66% less than what was collected to date in FY 2016 (\$9,100).
- The unaudited balance to date of Transportation Impact fees is \$43,322.

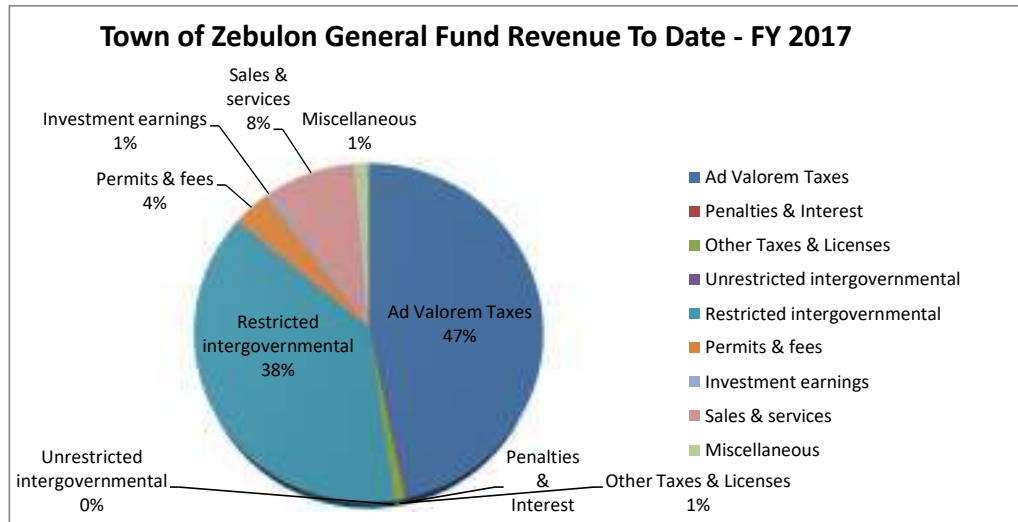
