Work Sessions throughout the year are structured primarily as opportunities for the Board to engage in dialogue with each other and deliberate upon the components of legislation slated for a vote at an upcoming Regular Meeting. The meetings also provide opportunities for either Staff to highlight the need for projects and programs to serve a community need, or the Board to vote on legislation that cannot wait until the next Regular Meeting.

Unless amended by the Board, May's Work Sessions are traditionally dedicated exclusively to items related to the Town's Budget for the coming fiscal year. At their Work Session on May 21, 2024, the Board scheduled this additional meeting.

2. Meeting Schedule

The Board of Commissioners is required to provide public notice of their meeting schedule, time, and place. The Board will consider two changes to their meeting schedule. First, moving the start of Work Sessions to 6 PM. Second, moving their Work Session scheduled for June 11, 2024 (possibly to June 13, 2024) to coincide with the date of the Transportation Bond Referendum Public Hearing.

3. FY '25 Budget

There are no presentations planned. The Work Session represents an opportunity to discuss the FY '25 Budget before the Budget Public Hearing scheduled for June 3, 2024.

4. Closed Session

The Board may consider a Closed Session "to establish, or instruct the public body's staff or negotiating agents concerning the position to be taken by or on behalf of the public body in negotiating the price and other material terms of a contract for the acquisition of real property by purchase, option, exchange, or lease".

NC General Statutes limits the Board's authority to exclude the public from their meetings. These exclusions are limited to the discussion of specific subjects, such as the acquisition of real property noted (§143-318.11). The Board may call for a Closed Session citing one of the permitted purposes.
