2. Little River Park Master Plan and FEMA Funding

Developing Little River Park was a top priority of the *Play Zebulon* Parks and Recreation Master Plan as adopted in 2021. Developing a site specific master plan for Little River Park is the first step in the process. The Board of Commissioners will hear details of the plan and the different funding opportunities to fund its construction, including FEMA funds.

3. Town of Zebulon Governing Board Rules of Procedure

The Board of Commissioners will receive a draft of the Rules of Procedure for "Agenda Setting" and the "Role of the Presiding Officer". Staff's presentation will reference Wake County's agenda setting protocol and recommend a version within Zebulon's current schedule and resources. - A. <u>Acquisition of Real Property:</u> "To establish, or to instruct the public body's staff or negotiating agents concerning the position to be taken by or on behalf of the public body in negotiating (i) the price and other material terms of a contract or proposed contract for the acquisition of real property by purchase, option, exchange, or lease ..." (GS § 143-318.11 (a)(5)).
- B. <u>Consult with Attorney:</u> "To consult with an attorney employed or retained by the public body in order to preserve the attorney-client privilege between the attorney and the public body, which privilege is hereby acknowledged. General policy matters may not be discussed in a closed session and nothing herein shall be construed to permit a public body to close a meeting that otherwise would be open merely because an attorney employed or retained by the public body is a participant. The public body may consider and give instructions to

- an attorney concerning the handling or settlement of a claim, judicial action, mediation, arbitration, or administrative procedure ..." (GS § 143-318.11 (a)(3)).
- C. <u>Personnel Discussions</u>: "To consider the qualifications, competence, performance, character, fitness, conditions of appointment, or conditions of initial employment of an individual public officer or employee or prospective public officer or employee; or to hear or investigate a complaint, charge, or grievance by or against an individual public officer or employee ..." (GS § 143-318.11 (a)(6)).
